- **Maundy Thursday notes:** We will have an Agapé meal in All Saints' Hall at 6 p.m. on Maundy Thursday, April 18. You are asked to bring a dish to share (with serving utensils). The dinner will be followed by a Eucharist in the Cathedral.

Following the service, the all-night Prayer Watch will begin. There is a sign-up sheet on the Cathedral's west side if you would like to watch for an hour during the night. More than one person can sign up for the same time. Security is provided throughout the night.

- **Easter Egg Hunt** – Easter Day, 9:45 a.m. If you have a child participating in the hunt, please bring 2 dozen candy-filled eggs per child (max 4 dozen per family) to the church office by Friday, April 19 (office closes at noon).
