PENTECOST is this Sunday, June 9

Pentecost is considered the birthday of the church and the feast day for Grace Cathedral. Because of that importance, it's the one day of the year in which we combine our two Sunday services into one service at 10 a.m.

The service will be followed by a parish picnic. The Cathedral will provide hot dogs, drinks and table service. We ask everyone to bring a dish (casserole, salad, side dish or dessert, for example) to share and a lawn chair or blanket if you would like to move outside, weather permitting.
